Introduction

- Hart District Council have secured COVID recovery funding from the Department of Transport and Local Enterprise Partnership for temporary pedestrianisation of part of Fleet Road.
- The decline of the high street has been accelerated by COVID-19 with footfall down sharply and a huge shift to online shopping. High streets are no longer shopping destinations and many businesses will close. Fleet BID believes that something needs to change or this decline will continue.
- Fleet BID sees this project as an opportunity to try something different, to encourage events and activities in the space available safely, to encourage people to return to the high street and support businesses.
